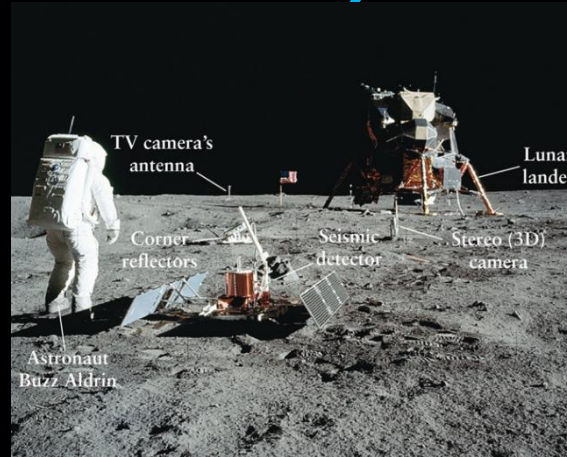


What if the Moon didn't exist?
