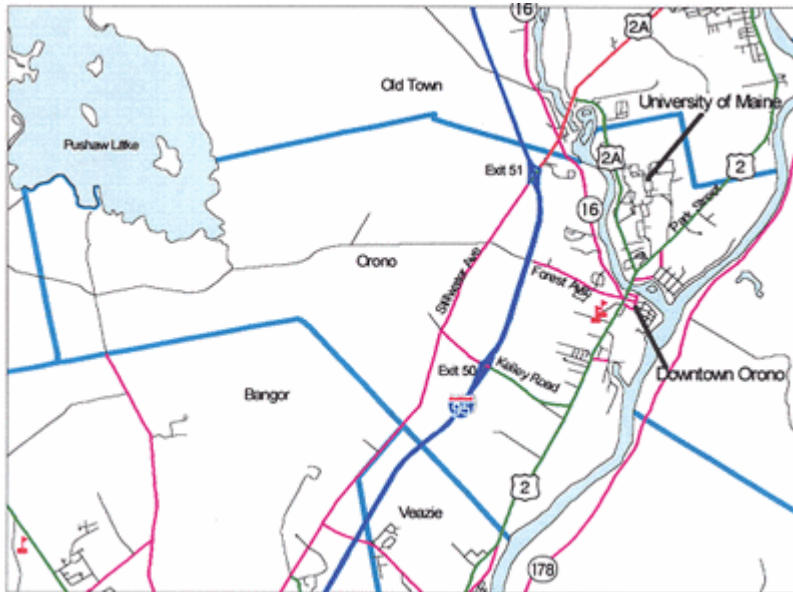


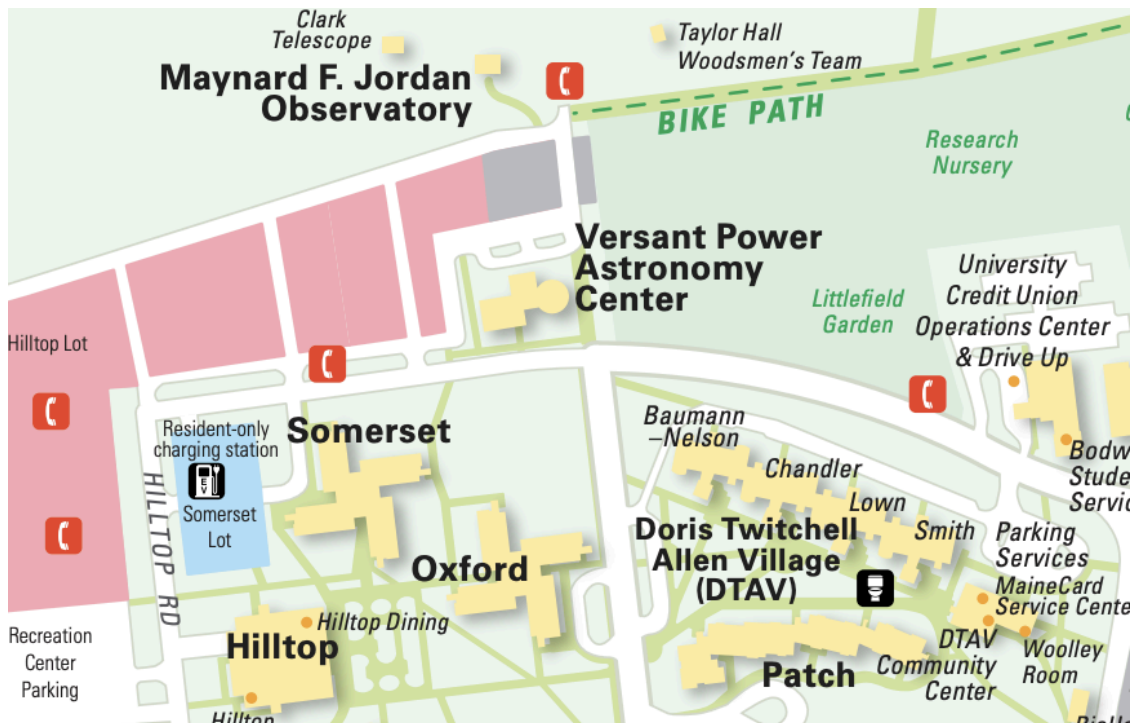
DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From Main Street (Rt.2) in Orono: Go north across the Stillwater River bridge and bear right at the traffic light onto Park St. Go one half mile, and turn left onto Rangeley Rd at the University of Maine entrance. Go 0.8 miles, bearing to the right at the fork in the road, and the Versant Power Astronomy Center will be on your right at the intersection of Rangeley and Long Roads.

From Interstate 95: Take exit 193 and follow Stillwater Avenue toward Old Town to the fourth traffic light. Turn right on College Avenue go one mile and turn left onto Long Rd. next to the Alfond Arena. Continue 0.7 miles around the "M" on Long Rd. The Versant Power Astronomy Center is visible at the end of Long Road. Turn left in front of the Astronomy Center onto Rangeley Rd. and then right into the parking lot. Visitor Car Parking is conveniently located behind the building, and buses can park in the pull out in front of the building.

PARKING FACILITIES at the University of Maine

Parking is now convenient, close, and safe for visitors to the Versant Power Astronomy Center's two entrances.

A parking permit is required for each passenger vehicle, so request them when arranging a show reservation, or call the office and pick them up on arrival. PLEASE give an estimate of the number you need in advance of the show date. On evenings and weekends, permits are also available at the Public Safety building on Rangeley Road.

Passenger Vehicles - If passengers cannot walk from the parking lot, please unload and load in front of the Astronomy Center and move vehicle to parking lot behind the building. Do not park or run standing vehicles in front of the building.

Bus Drivers ONLY - Drop-off for buses is in front of the Astronomy building. There is space for 2 buses, and parking is allowed even though this is also a campus shuttle stop. Buses can park and wait in the pull-off, right in front of the Center.

LEADERS

1. Please check-in at the planetarium office and give a count of your group with your payment, which you have collected in advance. Groups can enter the Astronomy Center upon arrival and go directly to the lobby.
2. Toilet facilities are located off the lobby, and everyone should use them before the program starts.
3. Leaders should decide in advance and notify the Planetarium before the show date, if their group will be purchasing souvenirs from the planetarium gift shop, which is open after showings. The shop offers many small, inexpensive toys, novelty items and souvenirs, ranging from \$1 to \$30.
4. The Versant Power Astronomy Center is accessible through either entrance.
5. In case of **EMERGENCY** on campus dial 911.

- VISITOR permits authorize parking in any black lot or visitor space.
- RED (Resident Student) permits authorize parking in red lots.
- BLACK (Commuter Student) permits authorize parking in black lots.
- BLUE (Faculty/Staff) permits authorize parking in any blue or black lot.
- GREEN (Carpool) permits authorize use of individually allocated spaces.
- FUTURE BLACK BEAR PARKING

Permits MUST be displayed on interior mirror.

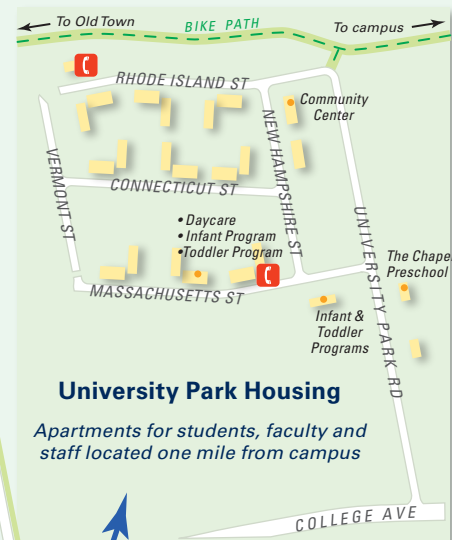
Signs governing lots take precedence over all maps and permits

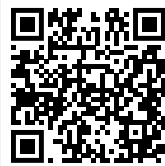
Visitor Parking
